2. Exodus	Exit from Egypt
3. Leviticus	Laws, Festivals, and Offerings
4. Numbers	Census, Laws, and Wandering in the wilderness
5. Deuteronomy	Sequel to Numbers ("second law"); Death of Moses
6. Joshua	Conquest and Division of the Promised Land
7. Judges	Cycle of Sin, Punishment, and Mercy; rulers prior to kings
8. Ruth	Est. family line of David; "kinsman- redeemer" as demonstrated by Boaz
9. 1 Samuel	Focuses on Saul's reign
10. 2 Samuel	Focuses on David's reign
11. 1 Kings	David, Solomon, and Elijah the prophet
12. 2 Kings	Elisha the prophet and Exile into Babylon
13. 1 Chronicles	Focuses on David's reign and Temple plans
14. 2 Chronicles	Focuses on the reign of Solomon, Kingdom division, and the southern kingdom of Judah
15. Ezra	Rebuilding the temple
16. Nehemiah	Rebuilding the city walls
17. Esther	Queen of Persia halts plot to exterminate God's people; deliverance
18. Job	Sovereignty and Suffering; "Why do the Righteous suffer?"
19. Psalms	Worship songs for Israel's every need
20. Proverbs	A resource for teaching Wisdom
21. Ecclesiastes	Exposes the necessary Emptiness of life without God
22. Song of Solomon	Celebration of Love in Marriage
23. Isaiah	Comfort for God's People in the promise of a Savior; the "fifth Gospel"
24. Jeremiah	Judgment, Jail, Fall of Jerusalem; through repentance comes blessing
25. Lamentations	Tears for Jerusalem and calling to God for His compassion and mercy
26. Ezekiel	Calling God's people to remain faithful to His promise to restore them to Jerusalem
27. Daniel	Dreams and visions to show God was in control of history and Israel's future
28. Hosea	God's relentless love: a Faithful God to an Unfaithful people

29. Joel	A call to repentance; known for its "army of Locusts"
30. Amos	Reminder of severity of divine judgment on covenant infidelity; Plumb Line analogy
31. Obadiah	God's Justice: hope for Judah with victory over enemies
32. Jonah	Nineveh used as reminder that God extends His mercy to all nations
33. Micah	Day in Court: preparation for Judah's Babylonian exile and future restoration
34. Nahum	Comforting Judah through Nineveh's condemnation
35. Habakkuk	Conversation with God: a personal struggle to give Israel hope in exile
36. Zephaniah	Day of the Lord: calling God's people to faith in the face of invasion
37. Haggai	Finishing the Temple in hope of great blessing
38. Zechariah	The coming Messiah as the Kingdom of God comes in its fulness
39. Malachi	Wake up call to renewed faith as the Messiah will make all things right
